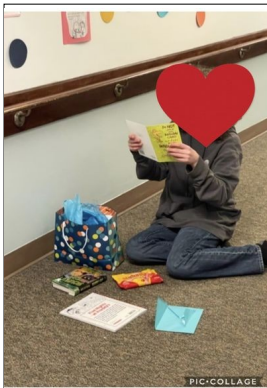




EVERY CHILD SHOULD BE ABLE TO HAVE A BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION!
