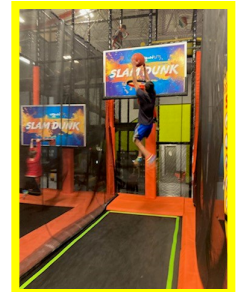
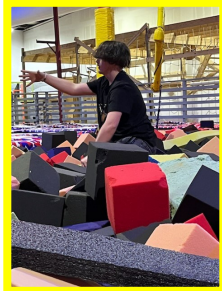
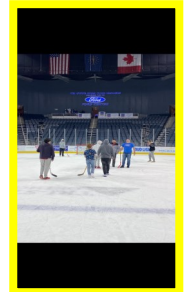
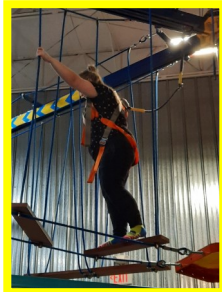




## THANK YOU FOR GIVING OUR RESIDENTS A WONDERFUL SPRING BREAK!
